2018-2019 State Senior BA Tournament Rules

- 1. Division:** Separate divisions for each of the six age classifications as follows: Super Seniors – 75 and over, Class A - 70 thru 74, Class B - 65 thru 69, Class C - 60 thru 64, Class D - 55 thru 59, and Class E - 50 thru 54. The age of the youngest bowler will determine the age group in the Doubles event. All ages are as of October 1, 2018.
- 2. Eligibility:** USBC and GA State rules will govern the tournament. Competition is limited to members of the Georgia State USBC BA who are members of a local association within the state. All entrants must have reached their 50th birthday on or before October 1, 2018. An eligible non-USBC member can qualify for entry by paying the \$24.00 USBC Associate membership. Bowlers will be required to show USBC card at check-in.
- 3. Entry Fees & Prizes:** All fees must accompany entry forms. The Prize ratio is 1-in-10 (one prize for each ten entries, or major portion thereof) within each division, including All Events. All prizes returned 100% in each division in the event in which collected. No entry fee will be refunded, except as allowed in USBC Rule 319C.
- 4. Participation:** Multiple participation will not be allowed. An entrant must enter Singles and Doubles. All-Events participation is optional.
- 5. Errors:** Errors in scoring must be reported within 24 hours after games are bowled. All claims for prize money must be made within 30 days after receipt of the prize list or the claim will be disallowed. Claims must be in writing to the tournament supervisor. Any protest affecting eligibility or general playing rules must be confirmed in writing to the Tournament Director or to USBC before the tournament prize payments are made.
- 6. Averages:** Bowlers must use their highest USBC 2017-2018 certified fall/winter/spring league average based on 21 or more games. Those not having a 2017-2018 certified fall/winter/spring league average may use their highest 2018 USBC certified summer league average of 21 or more games as of October 1, 2018. Those not having above averages must use their current certified league average of 21 or more games as of October 1, 2018. ***Averages must be verified by the Association Yearbook, League Secretary, or Association Manager, whichever is applicable.*** Those averages not meeting the above requirements, or averages not able to be verified, will result in bowler having to bowl scratch.
- 7. USBC Rules, 319a2 (10 pin rule) 319a3 (bowler's responsibility to verify average) and 319c (right to re-rate) do apply. 10 Pin rule is as of October 1, 2018. Rule 319d does NOT apply.**
- 8. Handicap:** Will be computed on 90% of the difference between the entering average and 230. Handicap will be figured on the individual basis on the three-game chart.
- 9. Line-Up:** No entrant shall change his or her position in any line-up. Check-in time will be 30 minutes prior to bowling schedule. If a change is necessary, it must be made by the Tournament Director at least prior to the time entrant is scheduled to bowl.
- 10. Scheduling:** Entrants will bowl singles first and doubles last if bowling 6 games consecutively. Preference in date and time will be given in the order entries are received. Requests for scheduling changes must be in writing to the Tournament Director.
- 11. Substitutes:** Doubles event – If a bowler cannot finish his/her series and a substitute is not available, zero (0) will be scored in the remaining frames. If a substitution is made, the handicap of the bowler with the highest average will be used for the game(s).
- 12. Tardy Players:** An entrant arriving late will be permitted to bowl with zeros for the missed frames and his/her score will begin in the frame being bowled. In the doubles event, the bowler present may bowl without a partner in order to qualify for All-Events.
- 13. All-Events Handicap Ties for USBC Senior Championship:** The All-Events handicap champion from each age division will be qualified to bowl in the next USBC Seniors Championship Tournament. In the event of a tie for the All-Events handicap championship, the bowler with the higher single game handicap will be declared the eligible bowler for the USBC Seniors Championship Tournament. In the event the 1st place person cannot attend, the entrants will be selected in descending order.
- 14. Dress Code:** All clothing must be neat, clean, and in good condition. Bowlers must wear a shirt with either a butterfly or mock type collar. All shirts must have sleeves. Casual slacks, trousers, jeans, walking shorts, culottes, and Capri pants are acceptable attire. During participation in any event bowlers are not permitted to wear headgear, sweats, short shorts, or skirts. Any bowler requesting a dress code exception must do so in writing and have a written doctor's exemption. Tournament management makes all final decisions on the dress code.
- 15. Tournament Director** reserves the right to add additional shifts as necessary and/or extend the tournament deadline.

Note 1: \$2.00 of the expense fee per bowler will be used to pay the entry fee to the USBC Seniors Championship Tournament. After tournament expenses, the balance will be used to help pay travel expenses for those traveling to the USBC Seniors Championships Tournament site.
